<p>Can you build your very own fire engine? Using objects from around your home (cardboard boxes/cereal boxes/lego/building bricks etc) Build a fire engine and add as many details as you can! Can you make a hose? Can you make ladder? How tall will your ladder be? How many wheels does it have? What about the windows?</p>	<p>Can you design and draw your very own fire engine? Will your fire engine have any special powers such as super strong jet hoses? What about a ladder that can reach all the way to the moon? Can you create some firefighters to go in your fire engine? Will they have any special powers?</p>	<p>Imagine your fire engine has been called out to an emergency! What would the emergency be? How will the firefighters help save the day? What equipment will they need? Can you create a story using your own toys to show what will happen?</p>

<p>Can you put together a story bag? (Using either small objects/toys/ drawn or printed and then cut out pictures) Add the objects to a bag and pull them out one by one. Use each object as props to make up your own story!</p> <p>Who is in your story? / What happens in your story? Where will your story take place?</p>	<p>Can you create a map of how your fire engine will reach the emergency? What shops or buildings will the fire engine pass? Will there be any trees on route? Whose houses will it pass? What about people? Can you draw the people who might see the fire engine whizz past? Can you create the road that the fire engine will drive on?</p>	<p>Can you remember the emergency number to call the fire brigade? 999 Can you make different sets of the number 9 using different objects? Eg: 9 small play people/ 9 raisins/ 9 cut out shapes etc</p> <p>Can you count out and separate 9 objects from a larger group of objects? Can you make 3 groups of 9 using items around your house to create a visual 9-9-9? Have a go at writing the numbers too!</p>
