If you need any additional pencils, paper or other stationery, please contact the school and we can arrange that for you to collect.


Move it...

Build it...	Design it....	Play it...
<p>Imagine you are an astronaut. You are being sent on a mission to outer space! You have been asked to build a rocket to take you. What could you use? Can you find any items around your home to help build and decorate your rocket?</p> <p>What shapes will you need for each part? You could use bottles, cardboard tubes, newspaper etc...</p>	<p>You have landed on a new planet and you meet an alien! I wonder what it looks like... What colour is it? How does it move? Does it talk? Can you design your very own alien and give it a name?</p> <p>If your alien has any friends or special powers, you could draw these or write labels so that everyone knows all about your design...</p>	<p>You have landed on a new planet. You meet an alien but it doesn't speak the same language as you. How can you communicate with it? Can you use your body to help the alien understand you? Can you learn the alien's language? I wonder what clothes or materials you have in your house that will make you look like an alien...</p>
Read it...	Write it....	Count it....

<p>We are going to start looking at sounds that have more than one spelling. The sound <b>ai</b>, as in <b>rai</b>n can also be written as <b>ay</b> (pl<b>ay</b>, stay) <b>a</b> (ap<b>ron</b>) <b>ea</b> (gr<b>ea</b>t) and <b>a-e</b> (sn<b>a</b>k<b>e</b>), which we call a split spelling. Can you sort these words into the headings? I wonder what you can see... How is it different from Earth? What's the weather like? Can you hear any noises? You could write a sentence, or start a space diary for each day of the week.</p> <p><i>Eg. This planet has massive holes and lots of purple trees. There are lumpy rocks floating past my head.</i></p>	<p>Practise counting forwards and backwards ready for the launch of your rocket! When the time is right prepare for countdown and BLAST OFF! Can you write the numbers in sequence going forwards and backwards? Practice counting forwards and backwards starting at different numbers e.g. 14, 13..12...</p>
