Maths

Learn: This week we are going to re-visit money. We need to recognise each coin and note.



Can you ask your parents for coins in their purse? Can you sort them into groups of the same coin?

Then we can count the coins to find the total amount. Remember to count the value of the coin and not just the number of coins.



$$1\text{p} + 1\text{p} + 1\text{p} + 1\text{p} = 4\text{p}$$



$$5\text{p} + 5\text{p} + 1\text{p} + 1\text{p} = 12\text{p}$$

Reading

Remember to listen to your child read every day. Remember to use the punctuation to guide reading and encourage the children to think about using expression as characters speak.

This week we will be focusing on past tense.

For regular words, you can add -ed to put them into the past tense

push - pushed

walk - walked

shout - shouted

For words ending in e, you just add the -d

move - moved

love - loved

use - used

For words ending in y, take off the y and add -ied

copy - copied

tally - tallied

cry - cried

For some words, they are irregular and don't follow any pattern.

see - saw

go - went

eat - ate
