



### Charles' group Home Learning week beginning 20/4/2020



<p><b>Information for Parents:</b></p> <p>This week we will be focusing on multiplication <math>\times 3</math> and <math>\times 4</math>. It will be very helpful to the children to get them to write out their <math>\times 3</math> or <math>\times 4</math> table facts before they do the Mymaths lessons because some of the activities are against the clock and they will be more successful if they revise the sequences first and then have in to refer to.</p>
