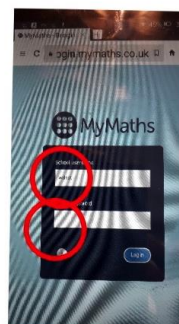
How to login to MyMaths using a Kindle Fire



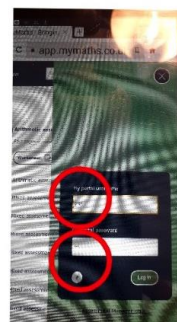
1/ select internet browser 'silk'

eg **zyk**

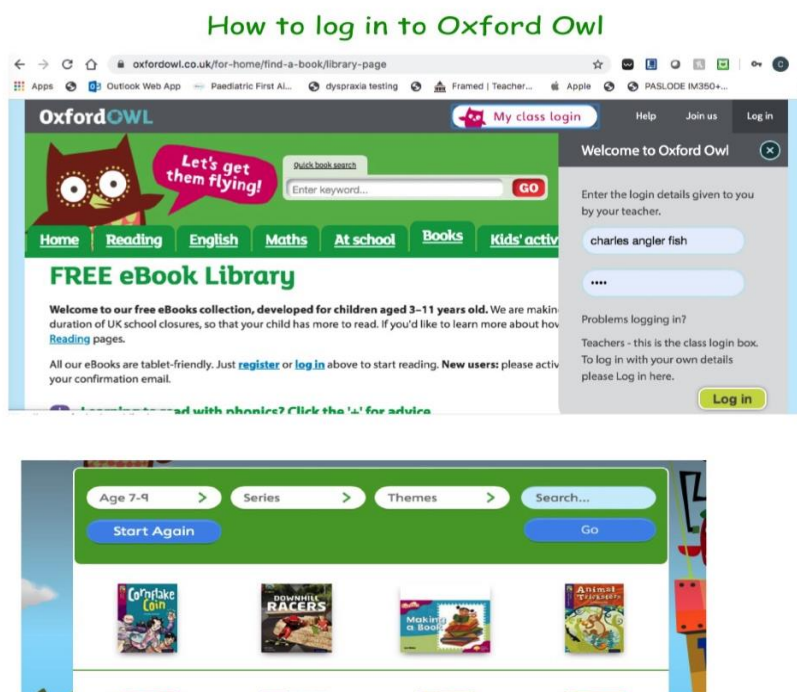
