<p>Sing it...</p> <p>Do you know any nursery rhymes about minibeasts? Here are a few to help you...</p> <p>Wiggly woo Incy wincy Spider The ants go marching</p> <p>Can you think of anymore? See if you can sing them and come up with your own actions to go with the words. If you are feeling really adventurous, you could come up with your own verse.</p>	<p>Make it...</p> <p>Finger print bugs! Using any colour paints you like use your thumb to print onto some paper. When the finger prints have dried use a pen or a pencil to add legs and any other feature your minibeast needs. How many different minibeasts can you create?</p> 	<p>Play it...</p> <p>Find some sticks big enough to make a noughts and crosses board. Use leaves and stones as your counters and see if you can beat an adult at home. Remember the aim of the game is to make three in a row while trying to stop your opponent from making a row of their counters!</p> 												
<p>Read it...</p> <p>We are going to look at the sound ee. These are available in lots of supermarkets and are very cheap! Follow the instructions and watch them grow! Write a cress diary explaining what it looks like every day. It's amazing how quickly it grows and changes! Try and use some descriptive words when explaining the changes. You can draw or take pictures of the changes too!</p>	<p>Learn it...</p> <p>Each week we will be creating a maths PowerPoint that will support your child's learning. These will be emailed each week.
