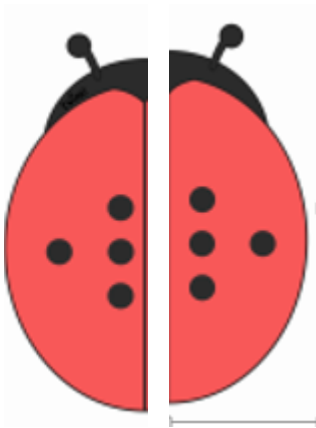

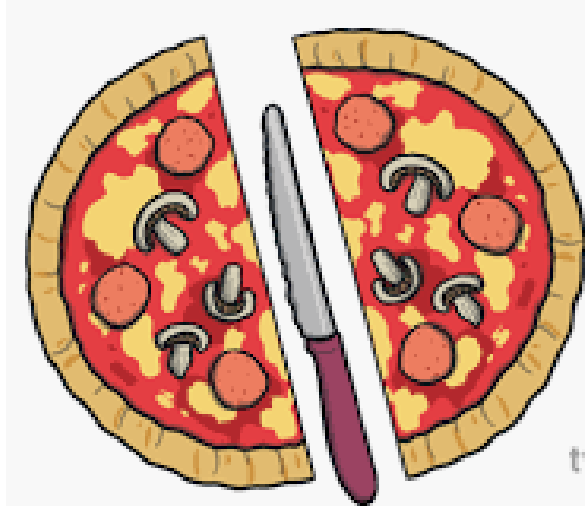

What is halving?



Half means to make **2 equal** parts. This then means the number you have gets **smaller** by **half** the **amount**!

Look at this picture. What do you see?



All of these items
have been cut in
half



They started as a **whole** but have
been cut into **2 equal parts**.

Some numbers can be shared into 2 equal groups of smaller numbers too!

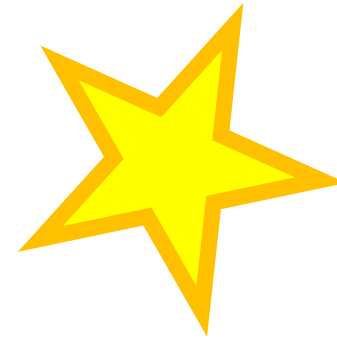
