



What is halving?








Half means to make 2 equal parts. This then means the number you have gets smaller by half the amount!

In a bag of sweets, there are 4 jelly beans. If we give 3 of them to Chris, is that fair?









No! They have not been shared equally!

Can you help share these candy canes equally?




Chris has a chocolate bar with 8 squares. He and Connor are trying to share it equally. Which picture shows them each having half?
