

Half full






LO: I understand different capacities

We can fill containers up to different amounts



What does empty mean?



What do you notice about all of these containers?





They are all empty! Empty means `to have nothing inside'

This glass of water is not full but its not empty!



It is half full! Half full means when the container has `half of its full capacity'

Look at these containers. Which is *full*?










Look at these containers. Which is empty?
