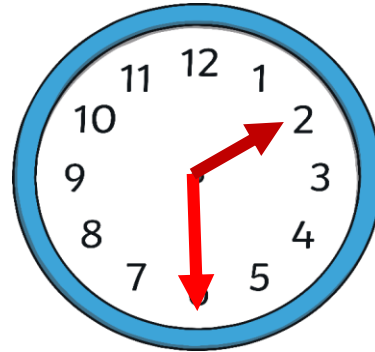

When a container is full it
means we cant fit anymore in
it!

What does empty mean?



What do you notice about all of these containers?

They are all empty!
Empty means 'to have nothing inside'

This glass of water is not full but its not empty!



It is half full!
Half full means
when the container
has 'half of its
full capacity'

The box is

nothing

Look at these containers. Which is *half full*?

The bottle of
water is not
empty or full!
It is *half full*
